The speed is building up as we zoom towards the end of term 4 (and another school year!) Next week we celebrate NAIDOC week with a range of activities organised by Ms Nelson, and in the following week we have the Colour Fun Run! A lot to look forward to!

REVIEW OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AND PROGRESS

Staff have been conducting scheduled Term 4 assessments in PAT Maths and Reading, investigating NAPLAN data and collating information on student achievement as we begin a review of the year's teaching and learning programs.

NAPLAN results provided many points to celebrate, particularly around the excellent progress made by the Year 5 cohort between 2019 assessments and 2021 assessments. In many domains tested, Year 5 performance was higher than that of 'like' schools, while Year 3 achievement reflected an improvement trend in most areas. There is an extensive amount of data provided, which staff will continue to investigate in the next few weeks. Below is a snapshot of Reading and Numeracy results.




