1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Your voluntary contribution is an important investment in your child/children's education. Families experiencing any difficulty in meeting this voluntary contribution are urged to contact the school office as soon as possible to discuss alternative payment arrangements.

Mathematics: materials for mathematics, focusing on problem solving and 'hands on' activities.

The Arts: continue supporting the excellent programs and help fund the purchase of equipment and consumable resources.

3. CHARGES FOR OPTIONAL EXTRA COMPONENTS

A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities etc. for 2026 has been included in the schedule attached. Details on charges collected in previous years have guided our 2026 schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the **maximum** charged for scheduled activities for 2026. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches. **Alternatively contact the school to arrange a continued payment plan.**

The charges schedule includes costs associated with specific learning activities that are available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made, e.g., incursions, excursions.

Specific learning activities are available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g., PEAC, School of Instrumental Music program etc.

Other activities are available to students but conditional on a payment being made.
e.g., Year 6 Activity Days, dance etc.

All payments are preferred via online payment into the school's bank account.
