

Connect Access for Students

How to Login to Connect for Students

1. Google connect.det.wa.edu.au

Most students have had experience logging into computers at school (excluding the Early Childhood). The Connect login for students is exactly the same as their school login. It is likely that some of our students may have forgotten their user name and their password. Please contact the school office if this is the case.

2. Type in your school student **User Name**, for example; john.smith (Please note that some students have numbers in their username.)
3. Type in your school student **Password**
4. **Tick** the “I have read and understand the Appropriate use of Online Services information” box
5. Click **Login**
