Enrolments for 2023

Kindergarten and Pre-Primary New Applications for 2023 close on Friday 22nd July.

Children born between 1st July 2018 and 30th June 2019 are eligible for Kindy in 2023.

Applications are available either at the Office, or on our Website.

We also require the following supporting documents:

- your child's birth certificate
- your child's Immunisation History Statement (AIR Statement Required) which must be dated within the last two months
- proof of your current address (e.g drivers licence, recent accounts for electricity, water or telephone,)
- copies of Family Court orders for confirmation of custody arrangements (if applicable)

On Saturday 21st May the Federal Election will take place and our school is a Polling Place.


This provides us with a great opportunity to fundraise through the wider school community.


