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**Boobook Owl Mural** 

Dear Greenmount families...

In recent years our school grounds have been the home of a beautiful family of Boobook Owls. The owls first visited our school around October 2017 and caused a great deal of excitement and interest in the school community.



In 2018, students from year 4 and 5 completed a Boobook Owl watercolour art project. For this project, students created pencil drawn realistic studies of the owls which they used to create a design for a water colour artwork. The Boobook Owl water colour painting featured above was completed by a year 5 student.



Mrs Stacy Gardoll, a local artist and a parent at

Greenmount Primary School, saw the beautiful watercolour drawings produced by the year 4 and 5 students in 2018 and generously offered to paint a mural at the school of the Boobook owls. Mrs Gardoll took copies of the drawings and paintings completed by our students and used them to come up with a design for the mural. She then presented a talk to the students, held in the school library, about the process she had undertaken to come up with her Boobook Owl mural design.

Students returned to school for Term 2 to see the blue background of Mrs Gardoll's Boobook Owl mural being painted. The whole school community is buzzing in anticipation to see what the mural will look like upon completion. Thank you Mrs Gardoll for your hard work and generosity, and for helping to make our school even more beautiful than it already is!


