Dear Greenmount families,

#### CLASSES 2021

Shortly, we will begin considering the placement of students in classes for 2021. This is a rigorous and thorough process as our aim is to create a balanced learning environment within all classrooms.

Firstly, classes for next year will be structured taking into account the projected number of students in each year level, the number of teachers employed at the school and the availability of resources and facilities. We also aim to have a class structure which will allow for any possible changes in enrolment numbers during the year, minimising the need to restructure during the school year.

Then, teachers and Admin will consider the placement of individual students into the agreed class structure. Placements are based on our teachers' professional judgements about students' educational needs and include the following considerations:

- · Balance of academic performance
- · Behaviour and social development
- · Work habits
- Students with special needs and students at educational risk
- · Previous class placements

Parent input regarding their child's educational needs will be considered, however, requests in relation to choice of teacher will not be considered as a placement factor. Parents have the opportunity to share any concerns that they may have regarding the educational needs of their child/children by forwarding this in writing to me before Friday 13th November for consideration.

Please also advise us if your child will not be attending Greenmount Primary School next year.




