NAPLAN on line

The National Literacy and Numeracy testing was completed online this year with everything running relatively smoothly. While there were some minor glitches with connectivity in a couple of sessions, students were able to complete assessments in an orderly and supported environment. Mrs McEwen and Ms Marotta had both participated in training last year and earlier this year for delivery of the NAPLAN online testing and supervised all groups doing the tests. Our IT systems—which have been progressively built up over recent years - worked well too! Thank you to all staff involved.
