Dear Greenmount families,

This year's Athletics and Faction Carnival have started well. 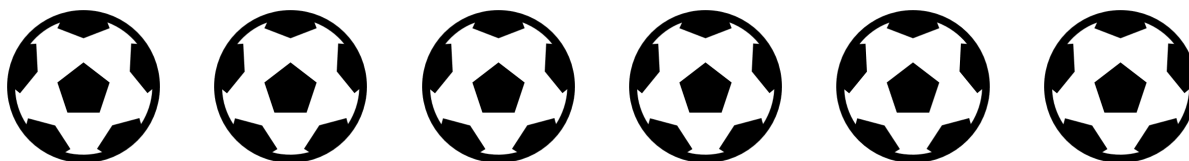
