### Voluntary Contributions and Fees

Payments of \$60—1 child, \$100—2 children, \$120—3 or more children can be paid at the front office either by cash or eftpos.

Mathletics payment (\$10 per child) is also required for each child PP to Yr 6. This provides all students with access to the program both at home and school.

- ♦ Kindy and Pre-primary students (and their parents/carers) use marked access gates to Junior area. Students and adults moving to Rooms 5-17 are asked to use the veranda or undercover area pathways
- ♦ Please label all items of uniform with your child's name clearly marked

With this in mind, we would ask that you be conscious of this when packing your children's recess and lunch each day.

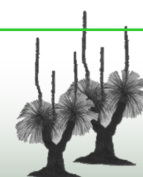
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## P&C Information
