## ANZAC SERVICE

Our Anzac Service is Thursday 22 April (tomorrow) held at the BlackBoy Hill Memorial site. Blackboy Hill was named after the Australian native "black boy" plants, Xanthorrhoea preissii, which dominated the site.

'On August 17, 1914, just 12 days after war was declared, the first volunteers arrived at the newly formed Blackboy Hill camp at the foot of the Darling Ranges. It was the birthplace of the Australian Imperial Force (AIF) in WA and over 32,000 men passed through the camp before heading off to war.'

The service is a registered event under Covid 19 Rules and therefore you will be required to sign in when attending using the 'SafeWAapp'.

The students and guests will be laying wreaths on the day and we ask you to consider donating flowers from your garden, or your time, to assist in the making of the wreaths Thursday morning in the staff room.
