Dear Greenmount families,

Thank you to all for your tremendously positive response and support of the changes we have implemented around safety and well being during current COVID restrictions.

As required, we have made some changes to movement around the school to minimise contact between different classes and adults on site. The students have adapted quickly to the revised play area schedule where Rooms 5-10 use the oval on one day, the courts on the next day, alternating with students from Room 12-17. Our younger students from Rooms 1-4 continue to use their familiar playground and surrounds.



Staggered exit times are running smoothly—thank you for your cooperation!
A reminder that the exit times are as follows:

2.45pm - Kindy students, Pre-primary students, and all family groups (students with siblings in the school)

2.55pm - All students without siblings in the school

3.00pm— All after school care students (family groups or individuals)

At this stage, parents and carers are not able to enter classrooms and masks must be worn on school site. We are also encouraging parents and carers to pick up and drop off from the school gates where possible, and leave school grounds promptly before and after school.

As we are not able to hold our usual introductory classroom meetings, all teachers have prepared an Information Package which will be sent out to all families next Wednesday.

This is information around classroom routines and expectations specific to your child's class.




