Dear Greenmount families,

As the situation around the COVID 19 continues to challenge us, I would like to provide some information and updates from the Health Department and Department of Education which impact on us here at Greenmount Primary School.

The decisions and actions we are taking are being made with everyone's safety and well being in mind, while being compliant with WA Government and Department of Education requirements. The aim is to minimise the number of students (and therefore families) who may come into contact with a positive COVID 19 case at school.

To this effect, the following procedures have been put in place:

- Specific play areas have been assigned to students according to their rooms (not year level) These groups are Rooms 1-4, Rooms 5-10 and Rooms 12 -17.
- Exit times have been staggered over a 15minute interval:

2.45pm - Kindy students, Pre-primary students, and all family groups (students with siblings in the school)

2.55pm - All students without siblings in the school

3.00pm– All after school care students (family groups or individuals)

- The gate for Rooms 1-5 access will remain closed until 8.30am beginning Thursday 3rd March. This is to minimise the amount of 'traffic' passing through the area.
- We encourage all parents and carers to drop off and pick up at school gates if possible.
- All adults on school site are required to wear masks and remain outside of classrooms.

With the Premier's announcement of public health measures being upgraded there is now a requirement for all students from Year 3 upwards to wear masks in the community and at school.

We appreciate that this may be challenging for some families and students, however, all staff will be mindful of your child's concerns while working within the Department of Education guidelines.

For those students now required to wear masks at school:

- * Please provide a mask from home –with student's name on it. Teachers have a limited supply for those students who may, on occasion forget to bring one from home.
- * Exemptions only apply with an approved medical certificate. Please provide this information to Admin.
- * You may also like to provide a resealable plastic bag for students to put masks in when they are out during break times when masks are not required to be worn.
- masks are not mandated for Year 2 students, however, for students in Year 2/3 classes, parents/ carers may opt to have their child wear a mask

At this stage, we are hopeful that scheduled school activities and events are able to go ahead.:

- ⇒ Our administrative staff will send out forms and collect payments for Swimming classes later in the term. We have been informed of possible changes to groups and times, but will not have confirmation until 11th March.
- ⇒ There may be changes to the format of the Faction Carnival, which can go ahead. Within current guidelines.

We acknowledge and respect the fact that parents and carers may have varying points of view around the current measures. We would like to continue to see students in attendance at school, and teachers available to teach face to face. We will continue to provide our families with updated information as we work through the challenges this term may bring.

Connect is an online platform used in many classes at the school. Currently, all students can login to their Connect account using their school log-in and password.

Over the last two years, all parents and carers listed as their child's first contact have also been registered and given access to Connect.
